

Bratislava Travel Information

1. By plane:

How to get from Vienna Schwechat International Airport to Bratislava?

Once you arrive to the airport of Vienna you are going to need to take bus to Bratislava. Walk out from airport to fresh air and bus stops are next to entrance on the right side (20 meters) of the airport entrance (see map). Journey time to the Bratislava Central Bus Station, is around 55 minutes. In Bratislava you can get off at three stops, be sure not to get off at the first stop. If you get off at the second one (called *Most SNP*), it will be a 5-10 minute walk to the hotel). It is best to go as far as Bus Central Station (*Mlynské Nivy*).

Its recommended to search and buy ticket before. You can do it on this website:

You can select English language. First, click on Timetable Selection and press “Buses”. Type “*Wien,,Flughafen Wien; Austria*” to **From** and “*Bratislava, AS*” to **TO** and find best alternative for you. You should be able to buy tickets with drivers, but its always best to buy them before and download tickets to phones to avoid stress.

If you buy your ticket online, it's best to buy it as soon as you land so you don't lose money if your plane is delayed, tickets are only valid for a particular bus. Prices are usually around 10-15 euros, varying depending on the time the buses run and the company that operates the line. If the plane landed much earlier, you would have to wait until your connection. If you hadn't bought your ticket online, it is possible to buy it directly from the driver, but the prices are not fixed and you may end up paying as much as 25 euros for a ticket.

How to get from Bratislava airport to your hotel?

Bratislava airport is small. Fastest way how to get to your hotel is to order Uber or Bolt. Taxi would cost you between 8-12 €

Other option is to use public transport. Ticket can be bought in kiosk. You can take bus n. 61 and at stop Račianske mýto transfer to tram 3 to Šafárikovo námestie and from there walk to your hotel (see map how to get to conference venue – Gondova street is next to Šafárikovo námestie).

2. By train

How to get from Bratislava main train station to your hotel? (trains from direction Prague or Budapest)

Fastest way how to get to your hotel is to order Uber or Bolt. Taxi would cost you between 8-12 €

Other option is to use public transport. Ticket can be bought in kiosk. You can take tram 3 to Šafárikovo námestie and from there walk to your hotel (see map how to get to conference venue – Gondova street is next to Šafárikovo námestie).

How to get from Bratislava- Petržalka train station to your hotel? (Trains from Vienna Central not from airport!)

Fastest way how to get to your hotel is to order Uber or Bolt. Taxi would cost you between 8-12 €

Other option is to use public transport. Ticket can be bought in kiosk. You can take autobus 99 and at stop Jungmanova transfer to tram 3 to Šafárikovo námestie and from there walk to your hotel (see map how to get to conference venue – Gondova street next to Šafárikovo námestie).

How to get from Bratislava main bus station to your hotel? (from all international destinations)

By foot it takes ten minutes or less.

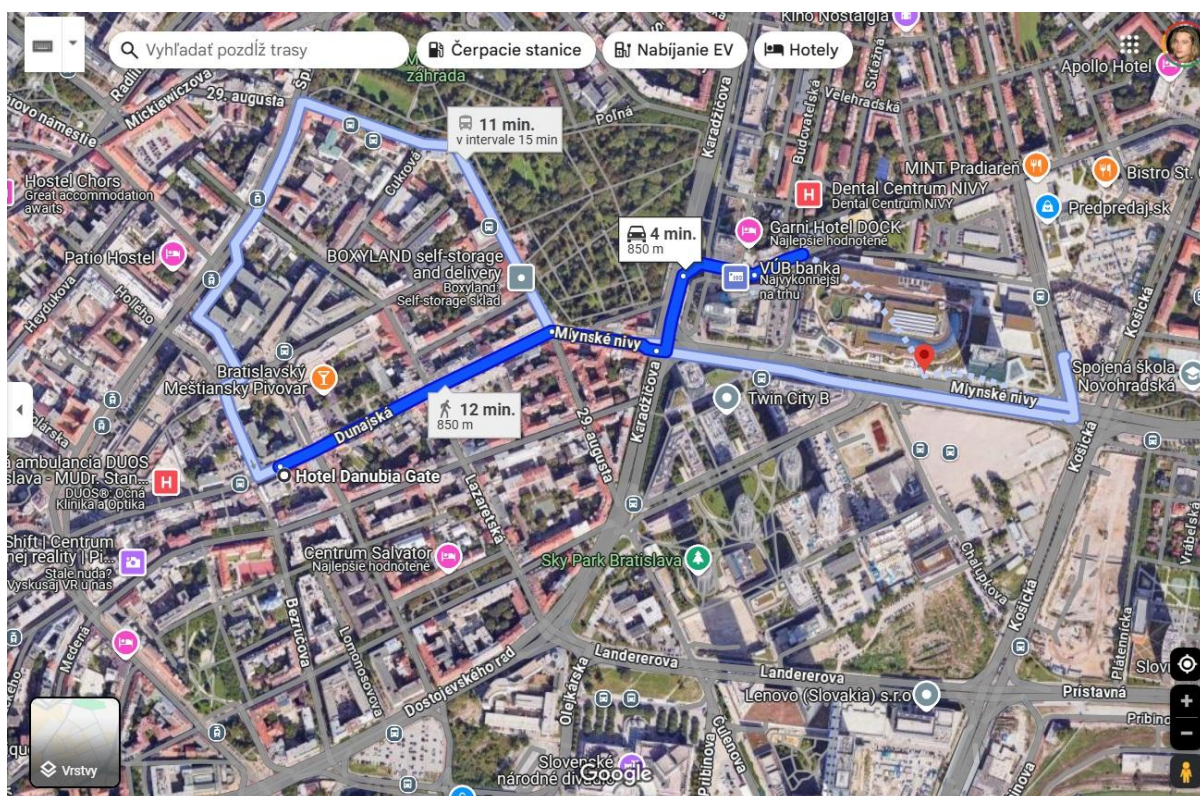
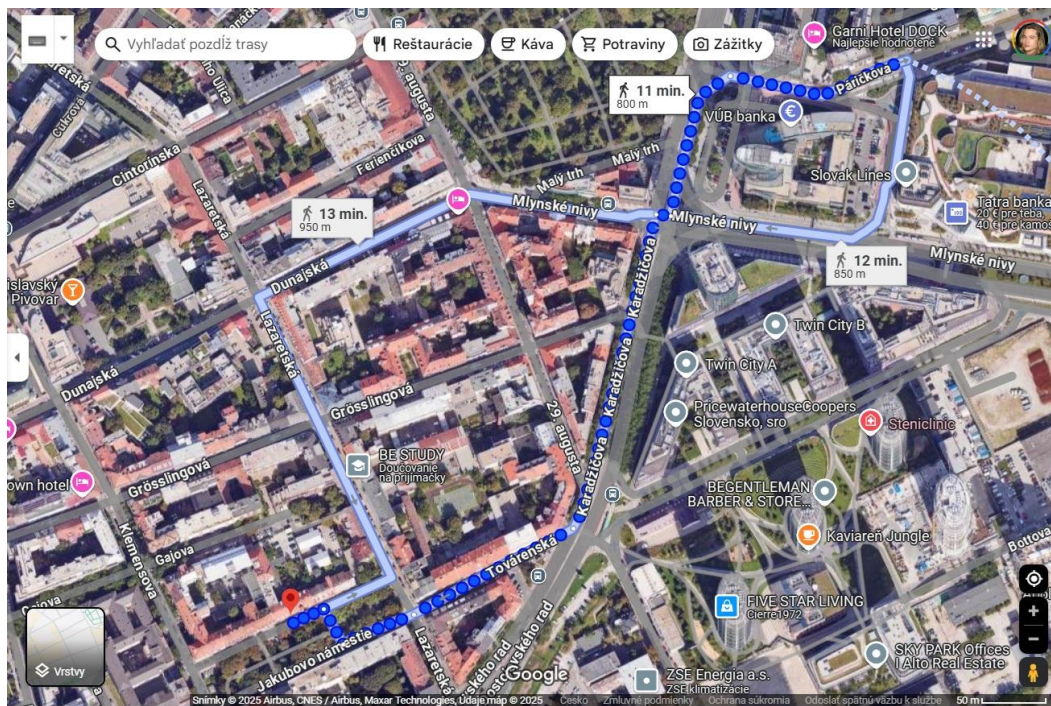
1) By taxi

Order taxi from Uber or Bolt, price should around 5€. You should be in 3 minutes at the hotel's lobby.

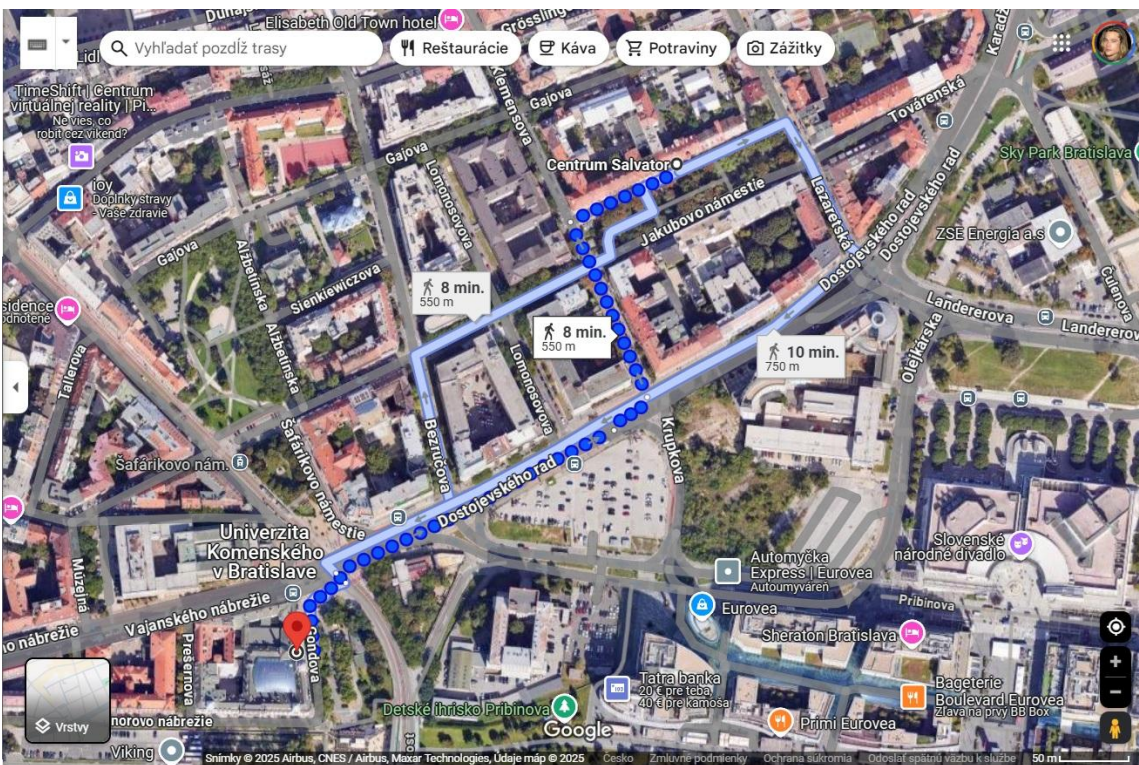
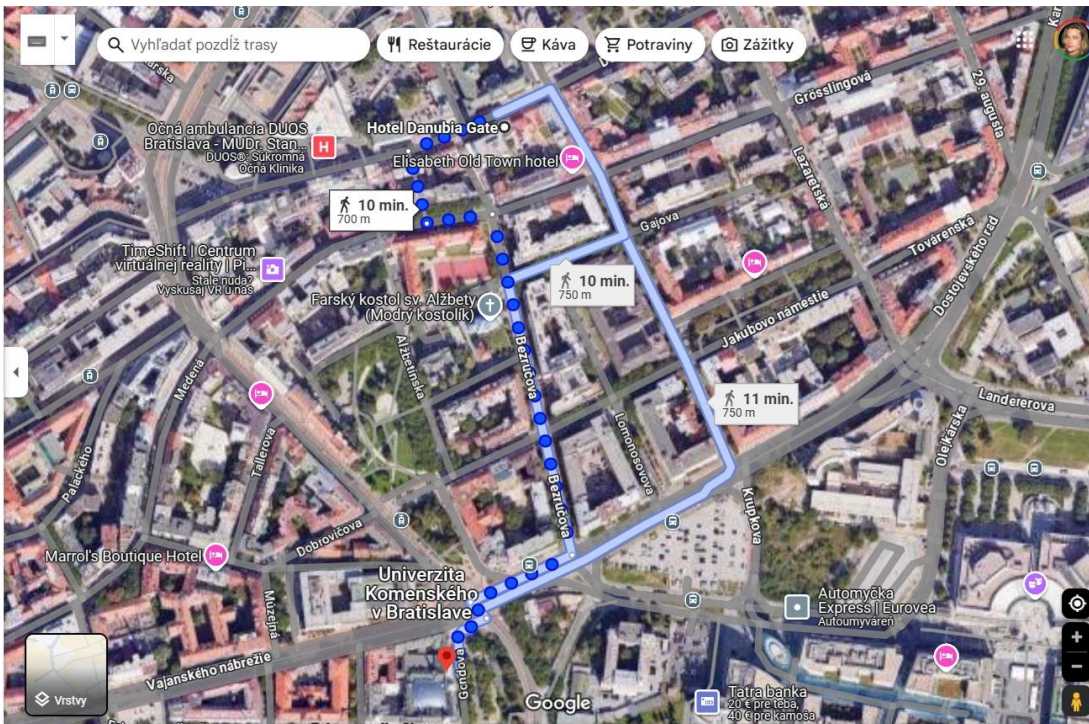
2) By public transport

You can take trolleybus number 72 from bus stop Bratislava, Autobusová stanica (Bratislava Central Bus Station) to end bus stop Rajska (3 minutes) and walk to hotel (5 minutes). You need to buy tickets for public transport – 30 minutes tickets (1,2€/ticket) and mark them when you enter trolleybus. The tickets can be bought at newstands selling newspapers and cigarettes or vending machines.

There are 3 bus stops near station – see the map for the correct one.

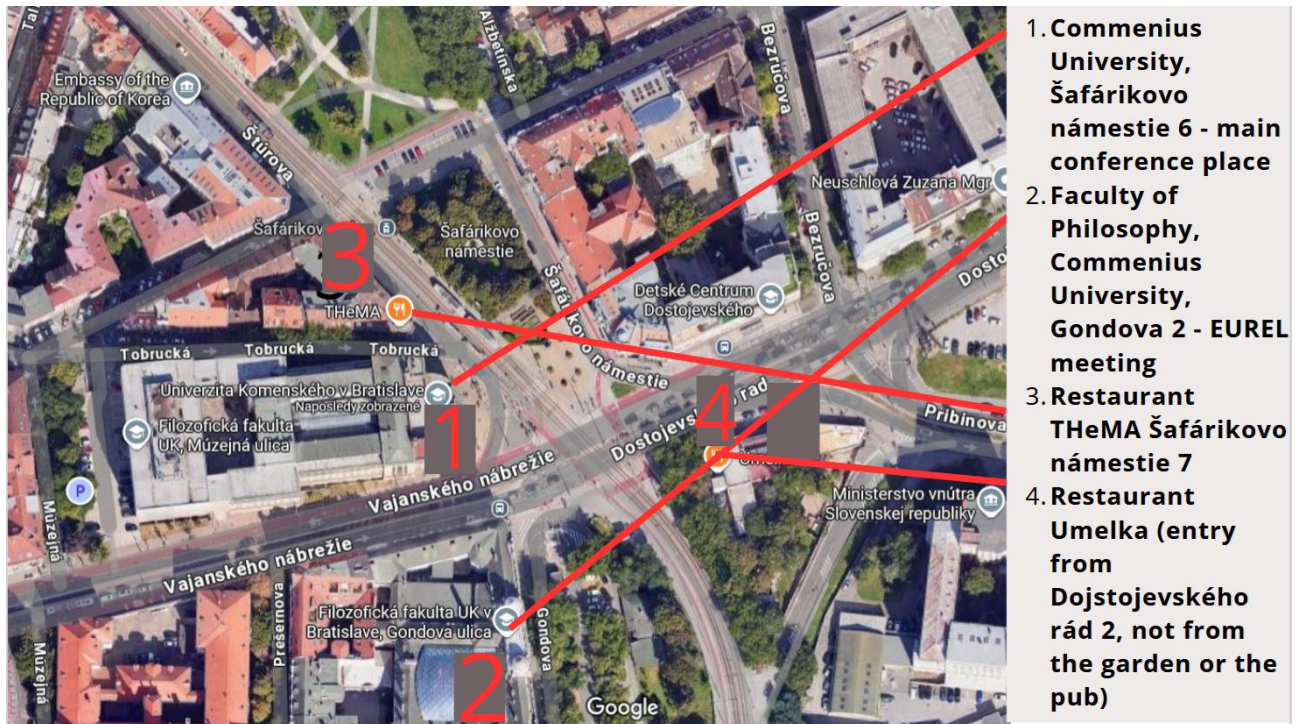


EUREL meeting venue: Room G 239, Faculty of Arts, Comenius University in Bratislava, Gondova 2

To go back at airport:

It's also best to buy your return bus ticket to Vienna Airport online in advance. The latest bus departure from Bratislava should be 3 hours before the plane departs, if you check-in online the day before you just need to take the bus 150 minutes before the plane departs.
